Institute for Rural Advancement (INFRA) is a training institution under the Ministry of Rural and Regional Development, Malaysia.

INFRA was established in 1996 and plays an effective role in building up the nation through the process of stratifying the rural human capital by providing training and non-formal education to the rural community and practitioners/ implementers alike regarding the management of rural development.

Apart from implementing training programmes for local participants, INFRA also serves as the focal institution in implementing international trainings, in collaboration with international organisations of which Malaysia is a member, including CIRDAP



CIRDAP

The Centre on Integrated Rural Development for Asia and the Pacific (CIRDAP) is a regional, intergovernmental and autonomous organisation.

It was established on 6 July 1979 at the initiative of the countries of the Asia-Pacific region and the Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) of the United Nations with support from several other UN bodies and donors.

The Centre came into being to meet the felt needs of the developing countries at that time as an institution for promoting integrated rural development in the region.

QUALIFICATIONS & REQUIREMENTS

The course is ideally suited for:

- Senior and middle -level goverment official;
- Policy and programme planners and implementers who are responsible for tourism/rural development programmes;
- Those nominated or appointed by their government;
- Those between the age of 25 55 years old;
- Proficiency in spoken and written English;
- In good health both physically and mentally with a certified medical acknowledgement that allows them to complete this course.

IMPORTANT

- All applicants must provide a valid email address written or printed legibly in the application form. Confirmation of the course and other notifications will be made using email
- Participants must have a valid passport with at least 6 months before expiring on the date of travel
- The cost of obtaining a visa is at the expense of the participants and is not covered under the sponsorship
- Participants are strictly not allowed to bring any family members during the course
- Participants are to dress in formal or office attire throughout the training sessions and during official visits to Government Ministries/ Agencies
- Participants are reminded to bring personal needs including adequate medication during the course period

FELLOWSHIP & SCHOLARSHIP

Participants will receive support from the Government of Malaysia and CIRDAP as the following:

AIR FARES

A return flight ticket from the capital city of the recipient country to Kuala Lumpur/ Penang states on economy class is provided by CIRDAP.

INSURANCE

Travel and health insurance for participants during the course including travel to and from the event will is provided by CIRDAP.

COURSE FEE

All course fees are borne by the Government of Malaysia
