









POPULATION




Percentage of rural population has been decreasing since 1970, from 71.6% to only 24.9% of Malaysia's total population






INTERNAL MIGRATION




AVERAGE MONTHLY INCOME: 1970-2022



POVERTY RATE






2022 POVERTY LINE INCOME
















What is Policy?




Basic framework in the implementation of government plans
