VI. Working experience in Milk Union.

Responsibilities and Duties as an officer in charge of Milk Union:

As an officer-in-charge, I have managed the entire operational work of Milk Chilling Center successfully and smoothly with the farmers for about 10 years under the Milk Producers' Cooperative Union Limited (Milk Vita). I have managed all the administrative activities of the factory including formation of the primary society, consulting establishment and management of the modern dairy farm, purchase of milk of the cooperative society, processing & quality control of milk and milk products, payment of milk price and supervision of all activities of the subordinates and cattle loan distribution to the farmers and repayment. During this period I have been working in 12 milk chilling centers in different districts of the country.

First of all we have prepared an annual work plan for smooth operation of the annual activities of the milk chilling centre. I have practical and participatory experience in implementing the below mentioned activities in milk chilling center under the annual action plan as an officer in charge.

* Responsibilities on Society related activities:

- Formation of primary milk producer's co-operative society with the dairy farmers as per co-operative law and rules in milk chilling center area;
- Prepare an annual milk collection plan based on the capacity of the milk chilling center and to collect milk throughout the year. In this case, by preparing the annual milk collection target sheet for each primary society and encouraging the concerned cooperative members of the society to collect milk accordingly. - > To make dairy farmers aware about hygienic milking and dairy farm management for quality milk production. For this purpose ensuring regular farm visits and counseling to dairy farmers;
- > To increase milk production by providing interest-free cow loans to the farmers for purchase of dairy cows and encouraging set up new dairy farms by farmers;

Responsibilities on Livestock rearing activities at the chilling centre:

- Providing modern technology and climate smart livestock practice based training to farmers on selection of more productive cow breeds suitable for rearing in the climate of Bangladesh, feed management, healthy housing management, reproductive management, hygienic milking, milk preservation and marketing:
- > Encouraging training to the dairy farmers on high yielding fodder cultivation and dry straw processing to ensure year-round supply of cattle feed at low cost;
- > Encouraging and providing training to dairy farmers on the care and management of newborn calves produced on their dairy farm;
- > Adoption of deworming and vaccination of livestock on their dairy farm as per annual schedule;
- To select sustainable milk producing breeds for the country considering the global climate and environment and to implement artificial insemination programs for the purpose of developing dairy cow breeds;
- To develop various leaflets, guidelines and training manuals on animal husbandry with a view to making farmers skilled and competent for dairy farming;
