The areas of research and teaching of Professor Nasrullah includes the broader field of governance, public administration and management, specifically the major issues and theories of Public Administration, Public Policy, Environmental Management, Local Government, Rural Development, Entrepreneurship Development, Public and Non-Profit Management, Total Quality Management, Organizational Behavior, and Human Resource Management, etc. Professor Amir Nasrullah has published 6 books, including *Mapping Governance Innovations: Perspectives from South Asia*, (Co-edited), Published by **Routledge India**, and *Rethinking Development in South Asia: Issues, Perspective and Practices*, (Co-edited), published by **Cambridge Scholars Publishing, London**.
