The Team accomplished a few works of National Importance I led as Head of KVIC, North East Region, KVIC, Ministry of MSME, Govt. of India (2018-22):

1. Partnering with Govt. of Assam, rehabilitated 26 Women Ceasefire Cadres of various factions in Assam;
2. Created 2.5 Lakh employments in the non-farm sector in North East Region;
3. Around 700 Traditional Potters assisted in enhancing skills and providing financial support;
4. KVIC created a world record at Kaziranga, Assam, in the implementation of the Beekeeping Scheme;
5. Transformed Boro Nianglo, a disturbed remote tribal village in Dima Hasao, Assam, through community work, livelihood and beekeeping development;
6. 100 women potters at Simen Sapori, a resettled village, Dhemaji, Assam, empowered under pottery scheme;
7. A Khadi unit at Kawali, Baksa Assam, vandalized by militants in 1987, was revived in 2021, providing livelihood to 65 women,
8. A Unique Business Model under Atmanirbhar Bharat was rolled out, providing livelihood to 70 tribal Women Agarbatti Artisans in Assam;
9. Under Project RE-HAB, elephant attacks on human inhabitants were brought under control in Goalpara, Assam, without harming the elephant in 2021.
