## CIRDAP-REEDS International Rural Development Innovation Challenge 2026

We are pleased to announce the results of the CIRDAP-REEDS International Rural Development Innovation Challenge-2026 organized by the Center on Integrated Rural Development for Asia and the Pacific (CIRDAP).
